

Student and Parent Survey

In term 3 we asked students and parents to complete a general **on line questionnaire**. Thank you to those of you that completed this and also gave a range of comments. This feedback enables us to measure levels of satisfaction against a number of areas and identify aspects for improvement.

The results are as follows:

Parents are most happy with school safety/ preparing students for their future/ students' enjoyment/ leadership & management of the school/ Teaching and progress their children are making/ the way the school listens to suggestions and concerns/ information received about progress/ behaviour/ helping students maintain a healthy lifestyle. Although 63% of parents felt the school helped them support their child's learning, this was the lowest score and an area in which to improve.

Students were most happy with leadership and management/ preparing them for their future/ learning in lessons/ the way adults cared about them/ feeling safe/ knowing how well they are doing and the way staff help them improve. They enjoy school and teachers are interested in their views.

Behaviour for learning and the healthy eating agenda were areas where the students felt there was room for improvement. We will be taking these views into account as we review our school development plan and set priorities for
